

## Uniform Regulations

All uniform items must be clearly named.

### **Summer Uniform (Terms 1 & 4):**

Formal- Boys and Girls:

- Polo Shirt
- Shorts (Boys and Girls)
- Skirt, Skort or Shorts (Girls)
- Black, leather lace up shoes and navy or black ankle or knee socks
- Black, leather sandals with a back strap, such as Roman sandals may be worn, but leather lace up shoes must be worn for technology classes
- School hats/caps are compulsory at morning interval and lunchtimes

PE Uniform- Boys and Girls:

- PE Shorts
- PE Shirt
- Sports shoes
- White ankle socks – plain

### **Winter Uniform (Terms 2 & 3):**

Formal – Boys and Girls:

- Polo Shirt
- Polar fleece Jacket
- Shorts or long trousers (boys)
- Skirt, Skort, Shorts or long trousers (girls)
- Black, leather, lace up shoes
- Navy blue or black ankle or knee length socks, black or navy tights
- School Beanie (optional)
- School Scarf (optional)

## PE Uniform – Boys and Girls

- PE Shorts
- PE Shirt
- Sports shoes
- White ankle socks – plain
  
- Children must wear full formal uniform to and from school.
- Children must bring a note from a parent or caregiver if they do not have all items of their uniform at school. If a child has incorrect uniform on three occasions without a written note, they will be given an after school detention.
- **Jewellery**- one watch and one pair of plain ear studs- one in each ear- are the only items of jewellery permitted. If children wish to wear a pendant or other adornment for cultural or religious reasons they must bring a note from a parent or caregiver. These must be worn inside the uniform.
- **Make up**- No make-up is permitted. This includes mascara, eye liner and nail polish.
- Uniforms need to be clean and repaired immediately if they are damaged or torn. Leather shoes need to be cleaned regularly. Shoes are to be laced up at all times.
- Long hair must be tied back at all times.

We are very proud of our uniform at Northcote Intermediate School and encourage our students to wear their uniform with pride in the school and the community.
